The Agriculture for Good **Government Political Action** Committee (AGGPAC) is Ohio Farm Bureau's political action committee that routinely monitors the voting records and political campaigns of Ohio's elected officials at the



state and national levels. Candidates are screened by local Farm Bureau members to determine if they are agriculture friendly and then AGGPAC supports their campaign.

What is AGGPAC's structure?

AGGPAC is a bipartisan committee of Farm Bureau leaders appointed by Ohio Farm Bureau's president.

How is AGGPAC funded?
